- 45 Prosecco, La Delfina – Veneto, Italy £25
125ml Glass £5
Gentle playful bubbles and lemon and pear fruit. Delicious at anytime!
- 46 Jansz Premium N.V. Cuvée – Tasmania, Australia £35
Tasmania is renowned as Australia's home of great quality sparkling wine. It's cool maritime climate is ideal to produce elegant wines to rival Champagne.
- 47 Joseph Perrier Cuvée Royale Brut – Champagne, France £50
Half Bottle £26
Pale gold in colour with a fine mousse and apple and pear fruit. Fresh bread notes and a touch of biscuit come from a minimum of 3 years ageing in the cellars.

Rose Wine...

- 41 Côtes de Provence Rosé, JL Quinson – Provence, France £23
125ml Glass £4.5 175ml Glass £6 250ml Glass £8
A vibrant, dry rose, with a nose of fresh strawberries and anise.
- 42 Pinot Noir Rosé, Domaine de La Baume – Languedoc, France £27
Pale salmon colour with delicate red berry aromas and a refreshing finish.

Dessert Wine & Port

- 50 Late Harvest Riesling 'Nectaría' Torres – Chile (50cl) £26
75ml Glass £4
Sweet lychee and rosewater aromas with a fresh finish of caramelised pineapple.
- 51 Grahams L.B.V. – Douro, Portugal 75ml Glass £4
Black cherry and chocolate notes with a rich body.
- 52 Grahams 10 Y.O. Tawny – Douro, Portugal 75ml Glass £5
Fruit compote and nut aromas with cinnamon and clove spice.
- 53 Walnut Brown Cream Sherry – Jerez, Spain 75ml Glass £4
Coffee and walnut flavours with Demerara sugar and toffee flavours.

White Wine...

1	Highveld Chenin Sauvignon – Western Cape, South Africa	£17
	125ml Glass	£3.5
	175ml Glass	£5
	250ml Glass	£6.5

The nose leads with the sauvignon aromatics; lime and gooseberry. Honeysuckle and apple from the Chenin follows on the palate.

2	Pinot Grigio La Delfina – Sicily, Italy	£18
	125ml Glass	£3.5
	175ml Glass	£5
	250ml Glass	£6.5

Everybody loves Pinot Grigio with its soft texture and pear and nutty aromas.

3	Cotes de Gascogne Blanc, Le Havre de Paix – Gascogne, France	£19
	Fresh and zingy white typical of the region. Blended from Ugni Blanc, Columbard and a touch of Sauvignon. Gooseberry and herbal notes.	

4	Sauvignon Blanc, Santa Helena – Valle Central, Chile	£22
	Crisp and refreshing, with aromas of grapefruit and lemon peel lending a fresh balance to the tropical fruit, plus some herbal notes from a drop of Semillon in the blend.	

5	Viognier, Château Routas – Provence, France	£23
	Peach flavours dominate this lush, medium-bodied white, which features honeydew melon and butter notes, with hints of cumin on the rich finish.	

6	Chardonnay Domaine du Cleray – Loire, France	£25
	This is a small domaine near the mouth of the Loire river. Cool climate and limestone soils give this a steely mineral flavour with a touch of green apple. Tastes just like a good Chablis.	

7	Picpoul de Pinet, Beauvignac – Pays d’Oc, France	£25
	Elegant aromas of citrus, pear and white flowers, and a crisp, mineral palate. Ideally suited to seafood.	

8 Gran Vina Sol, Torres – Penedes, Spain £26
 Gran Vina Sol was a pioneer in the production of cask-fermented Chardonnay in Spain. Chardonnay is blended with the local Parellada grape which gives a lemony freshness to the rich honey and floral aromas of the Chardonnay.

9 Pinot Gris, Giesen Estate- Marlborough, New Zealand £29
 125ml Glass £5.5
 175ml Glass £7.5
 250ml Glass £10

If you fancy trying something different from New Zealand, why not taste the second most planted white grape after the ubiquitous Sauvignon. Pinot Gris is the same grape as Pinot Grigio but made in a slightly fuller style. The palate is filled with pear drops, ripe peach and a hint of honey. Delicious!

10 Sauvignon Blanc, Stoneburn – Marlborough, New Zealand £30
 125ml Glass £5.5
 175ml Glass £7.5
 250ml Glass £10

A typically expressive Marlborough Sauvignon made by the famous Jane Hunter. Lifted aromas including gooseberry, red capsicum, passion fruit and newly mown hay.

11 Albariño, Pepa – Rias Baixas, Spain £31
 Very fashionable wine, made in the cooler corner of North West Spain. Full flavour of lychee and pineapple fruit, with broom and orange blossom.

12 Sauvignon Blanc Barrel Fermented, Giesen – Marlborough, New Zealand £45
 The Giesen brothers have taken a different approach to the traditional Marlborough Sauvignon, using wild yeast and letting the wine mature on its lees with a short spell in oak barrels giving it rich, toasty notes. The resulting wine is complex and full of tropical fruits, notably pineapple with a lovely creamy texture.

13 Chablis 1er Cru 'Montmains', Brocard – Chablis, France £49
 Grapes for this wine are grown on south-facing slopes of this famous vineyard. Spicy notes with flint and citrus fruit aromas on the nose, followed by a subtle palate showing beautiful minerality and notes of lemon.

20	Highveld Merlot Shiraz – Western Cape, South Africa	£17
	125ml Glass	£3.5

Spicy South African red showing the black pepper synonymous with the grape. Earthy tones and ripe bramble flavours in the glass.

21	Grenache Pinot Noir, Les Vignerons – Vin de France	£18
	An innovative blend showing the bright perfume of Grenache with soft red berries from the Pinot Noir.	

22	Cotes du Rhone, Victor Berard – Rhone, France	£21
	A bright and sassy example of the region. Soft and fruity with hints of white pepper and bramble. Spice lingers on the finish.	

23	Merlot, Santa Helena – Valle Central, Chile	£22
	125ml Glass	£4
	175ml Glass	£5.5
	250ml Glass	£7.5

This Merlot has a complex aroma combining ripe black fruits and sweet plums with vanilla and spice notes. A concentrated palate, with a very ripe, smooth structure.

24	Shiraz-Viognier Victoria Park – South Australia	£23
	Yalumba are proven masters with the Viognier grape and they use it here to soften the powerful Shiraz. Perfume and violets give way to blackcurrant and sweet spice flavours.	

25	Malbec Finca La Colonia, Norton – Mendoza, Argentina	£25
	125ml Glass	£4.5
	175ml Glass	£6

Argentina's signature grape variety; a full-bodied wine showing the typical dark berry fruit flavours.

26	Old Vines Rioja, Carlos Serres – Rioja, Spain	£27
	This wine is made from old Tempranillo vines at least 50 years old which give consistently excellent quality fruit.. It offers a nose full of fresh cherries, black fruit, liquorice and vanilla.	

- 27 Cabernet Sauvignon Reserva, Santa Digna – Chile £28
A great example of what Chile does so well with traditional Bordeaux grapes. Blackcurrant and blueberry, with mocha and roasted spices. Perfect with red meat.
- 28 Syrah, Domaine de la Baume – Pays d’Oc, France £29
125ml Glass £5.5
175ml Glass £7.5
250ml Glass £10
This was a standout wine we showcased at a dinner recently. This has all the class of A northern Rhone Syrah but at a fraction of the price. Black olive and pepepr notes leading to a fruity finish with bramble and cherry..
- 29 Passo Doble Malbec, Masi – Mendoza, Argentina £30
An interesting and versatile wine, made from a blend of Malbec and Corvina. The Malbec is dried to concentrate the flavours, a technique Masi perfected in Italy. Black cherry and bramble fruit, with clove and violets on the finish.
- 30 Pinot Noir , Stoneburn – Marlborough , New Zealand £35
A wine exhibiting raspberry and plum characters combined with the gentle spice flavours of French oak. Beautifully balanced with a light fresh texture.
- 31 Crozes-Hermitage ‘Petite Ruche’ Chapoutier – Rhone, France £39
Beautiful Rhone Syrah showing aromas of freshly cracked pepper and violets. Although full bodied the tannins are well managed to give a silky mouthful and a moreish quality!
- 32 Valpolicella Ripasso ‘San Rocco’ Tedeschi – Veneto, Italy £45
A unique wine made by adding the skins from Amarone wine to a fresh Valpolicella wine. This gives a much richer wine full of chocolate and a velvety smooth texture. Black cherry, liquorice and vanilla flavours and a long finish. A must-try wine.

“I used to think it was a silly affectation to drink different wines from different style glasses, but I have finally become a convert.

I definitely prefer drinking hearty macho reds from a ‘Bob the Builder’ tumbler and lighter, fruitier whites from a ‘Dora the Explorer’ glass.”
