27	Joseph Perrier Cuvée Royale Brut - Champagne, France	£49.95
	Half Bottle	£25.95
	Pale gold in colour with a fine mousse and apple and pear fruit. Fresh bread notes and a touch of biscuit come from a minimum of 3 years ageing in the cellars.

Sweet lychee and rosewater aromas with a fresh finish of caramelised pineapple.		
30	Grahams L.B.V. - Douro, Portugal	75ml Glass
	Black cherry and chocolate notes with a rich body.	£3.95
31	Grahams 10 Y.O. Tawny - Douro, Portugal	75ml Glass
	Fruit compote and nut aromas with cinnamon and clove spice.	£4.95

White Wine...

1	Highveld Chenin Sauvignon – Western Cape, South Africa	£14.95
	175ml Glass	£4.25
	250ml Glass	£5.50

The nose leads with the sauvignon aromatics; lime and gooseberry. Honeysuckle and apple from the Chenin follows on the palate.

2	Chardonnay Santa Luz 'Alba' – Valle Central, Chile	£15.95
	An unoaked wine showing the best qualities of the grape: luscious tropical fruit of melon and guava and a rounded texture.	
3	Pinot Grigio La Delfina – Sicily, Italy	£17.95
	175ml Glass	£4.95
	250ml Glass	£6.15

Everybody loves Pinot Grigio with its soft texture and pear and nutty aromas.

4	Sauvignon Blanc Gran Hacienda, Santa Rita – Valle Central, Chile	£19.95

	Crisp and refreshing, with aromas of grapefruit and lemon peel lending a fresh balance to the tropical fruit, plus some herbal notes from a drop of Semillon in the blend.	

5	Viognier, Château Routas – Provence, France	£22.50
	Peach flavours dominate this lush, medium-bodied white, which features honeydew melon and butter notes, with hints of cumin on the rich finish.	

6	Picpoul de Pinet, Beauvignac – Languedoc, France	£22.95
	175ml Glass	£5.95
	250ml Glass	£7.95

Elegant aromas of citrus, pear and white flowers, and a crisp, mineral palate. Ideally suited to seafood.

- 7 **Masianco, Masi – Veneto, Italy** £25.95
A white Amarone?! Cool crisp Pinot Grigio blended with late harvest Verduzzo that has been dried. Very complex and versatile white. Lemon zest and pear with honey and spice give the wine more weight and complexity.
- 8 **Stoneburn Sauvignon Blanc – Marlborough, New Zealand** £26.95
A typically expressive Marlborough Sauvignon made by the famous Jane Hunter. Lifted aromas including gooseberry, red capsicum, passion fruit and newly mown hay.
- 9 **Lolo Albariño – Rias Baixas, Spain** £28.95
Very fashionable wine, made in the cooler corner of North West Spain. Full flavour of lychee and pineapple fruit, with broom and orange blossom.
- 10 **Pewsey Vale Vineyard Riesling – Eden Valley, Australia** £35.95
From a single vineyard in the cool Eden Valley, this has a zippy arrival of lime and a waft of honeysuckle. The bone dry finish reveals the wet slate minerality and crispness that make this so enjoyable.
- 11 **Montagny 1er Cru, Bouchard – Burgundy, France** £39.95
Burgundy still makes the best quality Chardonnay in the world. This is produced by Bouchard Pere et Fils who are an ancient producer and own some of the finest vineyards in the region. Rich and textured, vanilla and coconut aromas with peach and citrus flavours.

12	Highveld Merlot Shiraz - Western Cape, South Africa	£14.95
	175ml Glass	£4.25

Spicy South African red showing the black pepper synonymous with the grape.
Earthy tones and ripe bramble flavours in the glass.

13	Cabernet Sauvignon Santa Luz 'Alba' - Valle Central, Chile	£15.95
	175ml Glass	£4.95
	250ml Glass	£6.15

Deep red with, jammy, cherry and black fruit aromas and flavours, with plenty of ripe tannins.

14	Nero d'Avola, Villa Cardini - Sicily, Italy	£17.95
	A red grape that produces very appealing wines. Big on fruit but not tannin, with sweet cherry flavours.	

15	Merlot Gran Hacienda, Santa Rita - Valle Central, Chile	£19.95
	175ml Glass	£5.30
	250ml Glass	£6.95

This Merlot has a complex aroma combining ripe black fruits and sweet plums with vanilla and spice notes. A Concentrated palate, with a very ripe, smooth structure.

16	Malbec Finca La Colonia, Norton - Mendoza, Argentina	£20.95
	Argentina's signature grape variety; a full-bodied wine showing the typical dark berry fruit flavours.	

17	Shiraz-Viognier Victoria Park - South Australia	£22.95
	175ml Glass	£5.95
	250ml Glass	£7.95

Yalumba are proven masters with the Viognier grape and they use it here to soften the powerful Shiraz. Perfume and violets give way to blackcurrant and sweet spice flavours.

- 18 Rioja Crianza Paternina 'Banda Azul' – Rioja, Spain £24.95
Paternina make some of Spain's most popular Rioja in the traditional style. Savoury with leather notes alongside cherry, currants and a touch of vanilla.
- 19 Cockburns of Leith Reserve Vintage Claret – Bordeaux, France £25.50
Cockburn's are Scotland's oldest wine merchant, serving the likes of Charles Dickens and Sir Walter Scott! A traditional style with blackcurrant fruit; fine, firm tannins and a hints of vanilla and spice.
- 20 Campofiorin, Masi – Veneto, Italy £29.95
Masi are masters of the Ripasso method, adding dried grapes to wine to cause a second fermentation. This is their signature wine full of mocha, cherry and toasty aromas.
- 21 Pinot Noir , Stoneburn – Marlborough , New Zealand £30.95
A wine exhibiting raspberry and plum characters combined with the gentle spice flavours of French oak. Beautifully balanced with a light fresh texture.
- 22 Shiraz Patchwork, Yalumba – Barossa, Australia £35.95
Elegant and powerful with a supple, silky texture. Masses of blueberry and blackberry fruit, and a minty lift offsetting the earthy, spicy notes. Great quality Barossa Shiraz.
- 23 Rioja Gran Reserva, Paternina – Rioja, Spain £41.95
The top of the Rioja classification with a minimum of five years aging, although in practice the wines improve over many more years. Made by Paternina who are well loved in Spain. Leather, cherry and briar, with candied nuts and caramel. A silky texture that is sure to be enjoyed, and a long finish to savour.

"I used to think it was a silly affectation to drink different wines from different style glasses,
but I have finally become a convert.

I definitely prefer drinking hearty macho reds from a 'Bob the Builder' tumbler and
lighter, fruitier whites from a 'Dora the Explorer' glass."
