- 45 Prosecco, La Delfina – Veneto, Italy £26
125ml Glass £5
Gentle playful bubbles and lemon and pear fruit. Delicious at anytime!
- 46 Jansz Premium N.V. Cuvée – Tasmania, Australia £39
Tasmania is renowned as Australia's home of great quality sparkling wine. It's cool maritime climate is ideal to produce elegant wines to rival Champagne.
- 47 Joseph Perrier Cuvée Royale Brut – Champagne, France £58
Half Bottle £29.5
Pale gold in colour with a fine mousse and apple and pear fruit. Fresh bread notes and a touch of biscuit come from a minimum of 3 years ageing in the cellars.

Rose Wine...

- 41 Château Routas Rosé – Provence, France £26
125ml Glass £4.75 175ml Glass £6.5 500ml Carafe £18
A vibrant, dry rose, with a nose of fresh strawberries and anise.
- 42 Charmeur Rosé, Château Ste Croix – Provence, France £34
The top cuvee from the chateau. Delicate fruit and an exquisite finish.

- 50 Late Harvest Viognier Sauvignon Blanc – Chile (50cl) £18
75ml Glass £4
Sweet lychee and rosewater aromas with a fresh finish of caramelised pineapple.
- 51 Grahams L.B.V. – Douro, Portugal £35
75ml Glass £4
Black cherry and chocolate notes with a rich body.
- 52 Grahams 10 Y.O. Tawny – Douro, Portugal £53
75ml Glass £5
Fruit compote and nut aromas with cinnamon and clove spice.
- 53 Walnut Brown Cream Sherry – Jerez, Spain £32
75ml Glass £4
Coffee and walnut aromas with Demerara sugar and toffee flavours.

White Wine...

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| 1 | Chenin Sauvignon, Highveld – Western Cape, South Africa | £18 |
| | 125ml Glass | £3.5 |
| | 175ml Glass | £5 |
| | 500ml Carafe | £13 |

The nose leads with the sauvignon aromatics; lime and gooseberry. Honeysuckle and apple from the Chenin follows on the palate.

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| 2 | Pinot Grigio La Delfina – Sicily, Italy | £19 |
| | 125ml Glass | £3.75 |
| | 175ml Glass | £5.5 |
| | 500ml Carafe | £14 |

Everybody loves Pinot Grigio with its soft texture and pear and nutty aromas.

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| 3 | Sauvignon Blanc, Santa Helena – Valle Central, Chile | £22.5 |
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- Crisp and refreshing, with aromas of grapefruit and lemon peel lending a fresh balance to the tropical fruit.

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| 4 | Airen Sauvignon Blanc, Vergel – Alicante, Spain | £23 |
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- Taken from their oldest unirrigated vines, this wine is full of texture and intrigue. Subtle herbaceous notes and pineapple and lemon fruit.

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| 5 | Viognier Reserva, Loma Negra – Rapel Valley, Chile | £24 |
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- Warm peach notes with lychee and rose petal aromas. A mouth filling wine that stands up to many dishes very well, a versatile wine.

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| 6 | Cotes du Rhone Blanc, Rocca Mauro – Rhone, France | £26 |
| | 125ml Glass | £4.75 |
| | 175ml Glass | £6.5 |
| | 500ml Carafe | £18 |

Delicious notes of pear and white flowers. A blend of classic Rhone grapes; Clairette, Grenache Blanc and Viognier.

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| 7 | Chardonnay Domaine du Cleray – Loire, France | £27 |
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This is a small domaine near the mouth of the Loire river. Cool climate and limestone soils give this a steely mineral flavour with a touch of green apple. Tastes just like a good Chablis.

- 8 Gavi, Tenute San Lorenzo – Piedmont, Italy £29
This characterful white has a lovely rounded texture with notes of almond, lemon curd and peach.
- 9 Pinot Gris, Giesen Estate- Marlborough, New Zealand £29
If you fancy trying something different from New Zealand, why not taste the second most planted white grape after the ubiquitous Sauvignon. Pinot Gris is the same grape as Pinot Grigio but made in a slightly fuller style. The palate is filled with pear drops, ripe peach and a hint of honey. Delicious!
- 10 Sauvignon Blanc, Stoneburn – Marlborough, New Zealand £30
125ml Glass £5.5
175ml Glass £7.5
500ml Carafe £21
A typically expressive Marlborough Sauvignon made by the famous Jane Hunter. Lifted aromas including gooseberry, red capsicum, passion fruit and newly mown hay.
- 11 Albariño, Pega – Rias Baixas, Spain £31
Very fashionable wine, made in the cooler corner of North West Spain. Full flavour of lychee and pineapple fruit, with broom and orange blossom.
- 12 Muscadet 'Vallet' Domaine du Cleray – Loire, France £35
Vallet is a single vineyard recognised as one of the finest in Sevre et Maine, the home of Muscadet. A concentrated nose of tangerine and mango leading to a palate that is salty and mineral, made richer by long aging sur lie. The finest Muscadet you will taste.
- 13 Pouilly-Fumé 'Les Criots', Christian Salmon – Loire, France £39
From a small producer who produces beautiful wines with great clarity and precision. Smoky and mineral aromas, with vine tomato and herbal flavours.

Red Wine...

- 20 Highveld Shiraz Merlot – Western Cape, South Africa £18
125ml Glass £3.5
175ml Glass £5
500ml Carafe £13
Spicy South African red with blackcurrant and toasty aromas leading to a fruity finish.
- 21 Grenache Pinot Noir, Les Vignerons – Vin de France £19
An innovative blend showing the bright perfume of Grenache with soft red berries from the Pinot Noir.
- 22 Merlot, Santa Helena – Valle Central, Chile £22.5
This Merlot has a complex aroma combining ripe black fruits and sweet plums with vanilla and spice notes. A Concentrated palate, with a very ripe, smooth structure.
- 23 Cotes du Rhone 'Tradition' Rocca Maura – Rhone, France £23
125ml Glass £4
175ml Glass £6
500ml Carafe £16.5
A bright and sassy example of the region. Soft and fruity with hints of white pepper and bramble. Spice lingers on the finish.
- 24 Shiraz-Viognier Victoria Park – South Australia £24
Yalumba are proven masters with the Viognier grape and they use it here to soften the powerful Shiraz. Perfume and violets give way to blackcurrant and sweet spice flavours.
- 25 Monastrell Syrah, Vermaçor – Alicante, Spain £25
125ml Glass £4.5
175ml Glass £6.5
500ml Carafe £17.5
A brilliant wine that really over-delivers. You might know Monastrell better as Mourvedre as it is called in France. In southern Spain it makes a rich fruity wine with blueberry and black pepper notes and a rich palate with vanilla and cherry pie flavours.
- 26 Old Vines Rioja, Carlos Serres – Rioja, Spain £29
This wine is made from old Tempranillo vines at least 50 years old which give consistently excellent quality fruit. It offers a nose full of fresh cherries, black fruit, liquorice and vanilla.

27	Malbec 'Fantasia' Mauricio Lorca – Uco Valley, Argentina	£29.5
	125ml Glass	£5.5
	175ml Glass	£7.5
	500ml Carafe	£21

Mauricio makes some stunning Malbecs, all with a signature freshness and purity of fruit. Rich and dark with notes of cocoa, espresso and blueberry.

28	Syrah, Domaine de la Baume – Pays d'Oc, France	£30
	This has all the class of a northern Rhone Syrah but at a fraction of the price. Black olive and pepper notes leading to a fruity finish with bramble and cherry.	

29	Vieux Chateau Jouans – St-Émilion, France	£32
	The right bank of Bordeaux makes svelte wines based on Merlot. This is a smooth claret, redolent with plums, cigar leaf and bramble fruits. Subtle spiciness on the finish.	

30	Pinot Noir, Stoneburn – Marlborough, New Zealand	£35
	125ml Glass	£6.5
	175ml Glass	£8.5
	500ml Carafe	£25

A wine exhibiting raspberry and plum characters combined with the gentle spice flavours of French oak. Beautifully balanced with a light fresh texture.

31	Lirac 'St Valentin' Rocca Maura – Rhone, France	£38
	Lirac is one of the Southern Rhone crus, not as well known as Chateauneuf-du-Pape but much better value. Aromas of freshly cracked pepper and violets, and a toasty undertone with sweet aromatic spices of cardamom and vanilla.	

32	Valpolicella Ripasso 'San Rocco' Tedeschi – Veneto, Italy	£45
	A unique wine made by adding the skins from Amarone wine to a fresh Valpolicella wine. This gives a much richer wine full of chocolate and a velvety smooth texture. Black cherry, liquorice and vanilla flavours and a long finish. A must-try wine.
