- 45 Prosecco 'Il Fresco' Millesimato, Villa Sandi £26.00 £5.00

TREVISI, ITALY

Intensely fruity aroma with clear hints of ripe golden apple along with hints of acacia. It is fresh and soft to the palate, with well-defined fruit and a harmonious finish which always leaves the longing for another glass.

- 46 Jansz Premium Cuvée £39.00

TASMANIA, AUSTRALIA

Tasmanian Sparkling wine made from the finest grapes grown in a cool climate. Full yellow-gold wine, with some cashew aromas, followed by an intense mix of stone fruit, citrus and strawberries set in a creamy mid-palate.

CHAMPAGNE, FRANCE

A remarkable and noble Champagne house still under family ownership. Fresh fruity aromas such as pear and red apple lead to richer fresh bread notes and a touch of biscuit. The wine is aged for a minimum of 3 years in their cellars giving complexity and sophistication.

The top cuvée from this domaine. Beautifully dry and elegant, with notes of strawberry, cherry and raspberry.

| The nose leads with the Sauvignon aromatics of lime and gooseberry. Honeysuckle and apple notes from the Chenin follow on the palate. | | | | |
| 2 Pinot Grigio, Folonari

| A pure nose revealing floral and fruity scents. You will be charmed with this light-bodied wine revealing a slender texture and a dry finish. | | | | |

<small>VALLE CENTRAL, CHILE</small> | £22.50 | | | |
| Herbal notes such as tomato leaf as well as fresh tropical fruit like grapefruit, pineapple, and mango. A fresh wine with balanced acidity which brings out the fruity sensation on the palate and a pleasing finish. | | | | |
| 4 Viognier, Château Routas
<small>PROVENCE, FRANCE</small> | £23.00 | | | |
| Peach flavours dominate this lush white, which features honeydew melon and coconut notes, with hints of cumin on the textured finish. | | | | |
| 5 Pecorino, Pemo
<small>ABRUZZO, ITALY</small> | £26.00 | | | |
| Pecorino is very fresh, zinging with lively citrus acidity, notes of tropical fruits and a subtle minerality which gives the wine a lovely balance. V | | | | |
| 6 Tempranillo Blanco 'Nube', Leza García
<small>RIOJA, SPAIN</small> | £26.50 | £19.00 | £6.50 | £4.75 |
| A unique white from a rare evolution of Tempranillo. Straw yellow colour with greenish tones and golden sparkles. Fine and elegant on the nose, subtle and intense aromas of lemon, melon and floral notes. The palate is fresh, balanced and tasty with an exquisite and long finish. V | | | | |
| 7 Chardonnay, Domaine du Cléray
<small>LOIRE, FRANCE</small> | £27.00 | £19.00 | £6.50 | £4.75 |
| A dead ringer for Chablis, this wine comes from a small property in the cool Loire valley. Oyster shell and crisp green apple, a complex and refreshing wine. V | | | | |
| 8 Gavi, Tenute San Lorenzo
<small>PIEDMONT, ITALY</small> | £29.00 | | | |
| This characterful white has a lovely rounded texture with notes of almond, lemon curd and peach. The finish is fresh and the hint of sea salt leaves you thirsty for more. | | | | |



- 9 Sauvignon Blanc, Stoneburn £30.00 £21.00 £7.50 £5.50
MARLBOROUGH, NEW ZEALAND

Named for the dry riverbeds piled with round pebbles around which the vines are grown. Stoneburn Sauvignon Blanc has intense aromas of tropical fruits balanced with fresh herbaceous notes. A very well-balanced example of the Marlborough style.

- 10 Albariño, Lenda £31.00
RÍAS BAIXAS, SPAIN

Beautiful floral and herbal notes are combined with an elegant minerality as well as citrus and white fruit. Medium-bodied ripe fruit precedes a long and pleasant finish. It combines well with fish, seafood and sushi, as well as pasta and white meats.

- 11 Chenin Blanc Wild Ferment, Delheim £33.00
STELLENBOSCH, SOUTH AFRICA

A truly beautiful display of sublime vineyards, minimal intervention winemaking and mother nature. Dominant fragrances of stone fruits and orange peel held together by a subtle hint of vanilla. Vibrant pear and green apple notes, a plentiful mouthfeel and lasting finish are in beautiful harmony on the palate.

- 12 Mâcon La Roche-Vineuse, Domaine Normand £35.00
BURGUNDY, FRANCE

A terrifically well-made Mâcon that shows balance and poise. There is an underlying power to the wine, but it is always complimented by a number of refreshing elements. Crisp fruit of lemon and apple, a stony note and almost salty on the finish. Youthful crisp acidity keeps the finish refreshing.

- 13 Pouilly-Fumé 'Les Criots', Christian Salmon £41.00
LOIRE, FRANCE

From a small producer who makes beautiful wines with great clarity and precision. Smoky and mineral aromas, with vine tomato and herbal flavours.

De-alcoholised White Wine



- 55 Natureo White (Muscat), Torres £14.00 £3.50 £2.50
PENEDÈS, SPAIN

Torres have been working on reducing alcohol levels in their regular wines, and also producing this alcohol-free example. Typical Muscat flavours still shine through with grape, kumquat and floral notes. 

Red Wine



- 20 Cabernet Shiraz, Highveld £18.50
WESTERN CAPE, SOUTH AFRICA
Cabernet grown in the Cape produces rich blackcurrant and cedar aromas leading to a round finish from the ripe Merlot.
- 21 Grenache Pinot Noir, Les Vignerons £19.50
VIN DE FRANCE
Ripe, juicy and soft this blends the floral nature of Grenache with soft red berries from the Pinot Noir.
- 22 Merlot, Santa Helena £22.50
VALLE CENTRAL, CHILE
A fresh Merlot with aromas of blackberry and plum. Subtle spicy notes also appear, intertwined with sweet vanilla hints.
- 23 Côtes-du-Rhône Tradition, Rocca Maura £23.50
RHÔNE, FRANCE
A traditionally-styled Côtes-du-Rhône blending Grenache, Syrah and Carignan. Redcurrants and cherries with a backbone of spice and earthy notes. **V**
- 24 Orot Tinto, Bodega Toresañas £24.00 £17.00 £6.00 £4.50
TORO, SPAIN
Toro is a great region still undiscovered by many, it offers a similar formula to Ribera del Duero with high elevation giving hot days and cool nights. A marked fruity nose with redcurrant and strawberry notes makes for a fresh, lively and balanced wine on the palate.
- 25 Monastrell Syrah 'Barrica', Vermador £25.00
ALICANTE, SPAIN
A fantastic wine that over-delivers at the price. Blueberry and cracked black pepper notes on the youthful nose lead to a rich palate with vanilla from the wood and cherry pie flavours. **V**
- 26 Heilan Coo, Shiraz Mataro £27.00
VICTORIA, AUSTRALIA
Celebrating the iconic Highland cow which admired Australia as here for their gentle nature and high-quality beef. The wine is a sumptuous drop, dripping with plum and chocolate flavours. The Mataro adds a depth and subtle spice to the wine.
- 27 Rioja Crianza, Valdepalacios £28.00
RIOJA, SPAIN
The wine occupies a sweet spot where oak and fruit mix together and complement each other perfectly. Complex and intense aromas with cocoa and mulberry notes. **V**



28 Malbec Fantasia, Mauricio Lorca £29.50 £21.00 £7.50 £5.50

UCO VALLEY, ARGENTINA

Mauricio makes some stunning Malbecs, all with a signature freshness and purity of fruit. Rich and dark with notes of cocoa, espresso, and blueberry. **V**

29 Vieux Château Jouans £32.00

ST-ÉMILION, FRANCE

Good depth of fruit, dark plums, blackcurrant, and blueberry as well as the rich cocoa spice. Merlot leads the way of course being from St Émilion with around 10% Cabernet Sauvignon in the blend. This is joyful with its fruit and has been sympathetically made such that the tannins are soft and ripe, and so perfectly enjoyable immediately.

30 Pinot Noir, Marea £35.00 £25.00 £8.50 £6.50

LEYDA VALLEY, CHILE

Terrific example of what Chile can achieve with this fickle grape. Grown in a cool, seaside vineyard giving fresh strawberries, cherries and toasted earth on the nose. Very expressive palate; fresh, juicy and rounded with cedar, vanilla and plum notes leading to a focussed finish.

31 Cabernet Franc Reserve 'Punto Final', Renacer £39.00

MENDOZA, ARGENTINA

Fast becoming another of Argentina's signature reds, this Cabernet Franc straddles a nice line between ripe sweet fruit and freshness which the variety classically delivers. It opens with notes of black pepper, eucalyptus and fresh mint aromas that merge with notes of vanilla and chocolate. Soft touches of French oak provide complexity and elegance. Good body and concentration with a long and persistent finish.

32 Valpolicella Ripasso Superiore 'San Rocco', £45.00

Tejeschi

VENETO, ITALY

Made using the ancient wine making technique 'ripasso' where dried grape skins from Amarone are added to the wine to give it more depth and body. This is a rich and concentrated wine with raspberry, kirsch and cocoa notes.

De-alcoholised Red Wine



56 Natureo Red (Syrah), Torres £14.00 £3.50 £2.50

PENEDÈS, SPAIN

Showing the same care that they do with all their wines, a part of this wine is aged in French oak for four to six months prior to dealcoholisation using the Spinning Cone technique. Lovely, lively hedgerow fruit on a well-balanced and juicy palate. **V**

Vat 5, De Bortoli

HALF BOTTLE

RIVERINA, AUSTRALIA

De Bortoli are known worldwide for the quality of their dessert wines. Luscious and intense with notes of citrus, apricot and honey. Aged for 12 months in oak, giving added complexity and development.

51 Graham's L.B.V. Port £35.00 £4.00

DOURO, PORTUGAL

An intense deep red colour. The wine has distinctive floral aromatics of violets and rock rose, which reflect the importance of the Touriga Nacional variety in the wine's composition. In the mouth it is compact, ripe black fruit flavours marry fresh, spicy notes from the Sousão. The finish is typically Graham's with the signature balance between complexity and elegance. This wine sets a benchmark for the category.

52 Graham's 10 y.o. Tawny Port £53.00 £5.00

DOURO, PORTUGAL

It shows complex nutty aromas combined with hints of honey and figs then, rich mature fruit flavours, beautifully mellowed with a luscious long finished. Nicely rounded, spicy and raisiny with some fruit but also lovely woody, raisin notes. Think a fruit and nut chocolate bar! Great with apple pie.

53 Walnut Brown Sherry, Williams & Humbert £32.00 £4.00

JEREZ, SPAIN

A very sweet Oloroso, dark mahogany, almost ebony. On the nose, dried nuts and faint aroma of raisins, muscatel, and toasted sugar, with a smooth, long, and velvety finish. The sweetness of Oloroso comes from the addition of Pedro Ximenez and Moscatel grapes to Oloroso being aged in Solera system for over 5 years. ✓
